

HELL DIVE PICTOGRAPHS



OFF THE BEATEN PATH:	YES
BEST SEASON:	SPRING SUMMER AND FALL
VEHICLE:	HIGH CLEARANCE 4WD/ATV
HIKING:	.25 MILE
AVERAGE TIME:	1 DAY
DIFFICULTY:	VERY DIFFICULT IN SPOTS. SOME EXTREME ROCK CRAWLING.
ELEVATION:	5525 FEET

- GETTING THERE:**
- Drive 8 miles north of Kanab, just past Milepost 71, turn west onto Hancock Road.
 - Turn left on Road 50. 4WD is required from here.
 - The next intersection, turn right on road 51.
 - When the road T's stay left to the end of the road.
 - Park, look east and you will see the alcove and a faint trail.
 - Hike along the wall until you reach the alcove.

DISCLAIMER:

"This map and directions are intended for general reference use only. Always check local road and weather conditions. Stay on designated roads. Dirt roads are impassable when wet. Please respect Private Property. Be prepared for a wilderness experience: Always bring extra water, food, sunscreen, and supplies. Cell phone service is non-existent in most areas! Do not remove artifacts or deface the 'rock art'. Leave no trace of your visit so others may enjoy."

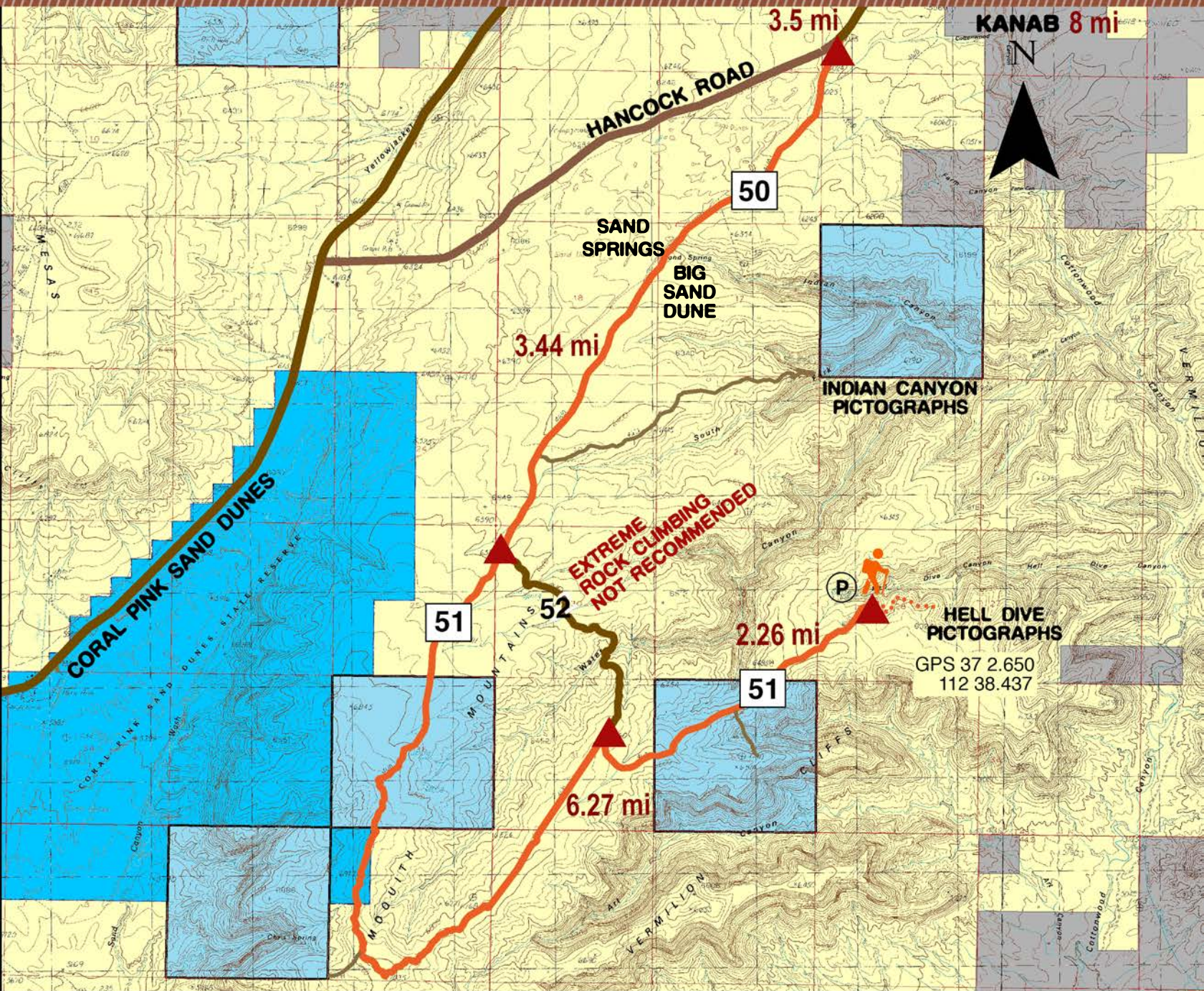

Locals call this site Medicine Man Cave because of the many intriguing rock art pictographs and ceremonial symbols. Early farmers may have used this area for food storage and preparation, as evidenced by the many metate grinding locations, grooves and storage pits. This cave may have been a place for women to have child birth, hence the babies feet and the fertility God Kokopelli painted on the walls. Whatever the cave's use, you feel a peaceful spiritual renewal here. Getting to Hell Dive can be somewhat challenging—**high clearance 4 wheel drive is required**. Use road 51; 52 requires extreme rock climbing and should be avoided. Be sure to stop and enjoy the spectacular views of Zion in the distance. *Please do not touch or deface rock art and Leave no trace.*
